Financial Update to end of May 2017

The table above provides a brief summary of St. John's finances as of May 31, 2017. You can see that we had a deficit of \$9,037 at that time. In the budget that was presented at vestry, we projected that by the end of May, we would be approximately \$1,855 in arrears.

Our total income received to the end of May is short \$5,329 of the budget projection for this time period. An analysis of our financial situation shows that we are ~\$3,250 behind our year-to-date budget projection for overall donations to St. John's. Also, we have only received one of our quarterly payments of interest from the Consolidated Trust Fund. On a more positive note, our year-to-date envelope givings are ~\$2,900 higher than the budget projection. This is GREAT NEWS and we thank you for your ongoing financial support.

You will notice that our year-to-date expenses are \$1,823 above the budget projection to May 30th. This larger than expected year-to-date expense can be largely accounted for by realizing that we have already paid the total yearly fee for some budgeted items. In the calculation of the budget to date expense these costs are spread across the whole 12 months of 2017. Also, our actual heating and hydro expenses were higher than projected in the year-to-date expense. We continue to monitor our expenses.
